**GUEST LECTURE BY S&H , MATHEMATICS WING**

**19.11.2018**

S&H Department, LIET had organized a guest lecture on “MI - Mathematics And Its Applications” for the students of B–Tech I year in CSE Seminar Hall, LIET, a Multi-purpose Hall, on 19 Nov 2018. The Speaker for the lecture was Dr. Mohammed Younus, Professor, Department of Mathematics, Kesav Memorial Institute of Technology, Hyderabad.

Dr. Rajasree Rao, Principal, LIET felicitated Dr. Mohammed Younus, Prof. Syeda Nusrath Fatima, introduced the speaker and the topic of the lecture to the students. Mr. Mohammed Ali, Ms. Jabeen, and other faculty members of Mathematics Dept were the attendees of the Program. In his lecture, Dr. Mohammed Younus discussed the importance of Mathematics in the field of Engineering and emphasized on the point that no one can become perfect without the basic knowledge of Mathematics in Engineering. He also introduced the participants to many exclusive examples and challenges in the world of Engineering with regard to Mathematics at large by stating reference to different innovative applications. He shared his own experiences as to how and why the students can no longer just rely on the old formula of rote learning. According to him, regular practice is needed to master the skills in Mathematics. He clarified the doubts expressed by the students with patience and the students felt relished for the content covered, which was beneficial for them. The lecture was followed by interaction session wherein the students posed various questions related to the topic as it was part of their curriculum. This lecture was a great opportunity for students who are going to write their final semester examinations in the near future.
