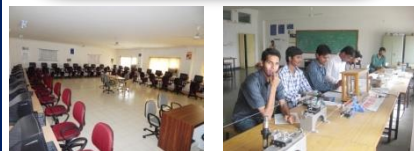

## EVENTS CONDUCTED BY S&H DEPARTMENT

### 1. FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME ON "EFFECTIVE TEACHING METHODOLOGIES & MENTORING" DATE: 09.01. 2020

Department of Science and Humanities of LIET conducted a Faculty Development Programme on "Effective Teaching Methodologies & Mentoring" headed by Dr. J. Sasi Kiran, Professor in CSE & Dean -1<sup>st</sup> Year. He explained about novel teaching methodologies, tips and strategies on effective mentoring. The session was an eye opener to newly inducted faculty. The meeting was attended by all First year Teaching and Lab Faculties. He quoted "if you ask any successful business person, they will always have had a great mentor at some point of life". Furthermore he added that mentoring is a one to one relationship between a mentor and mentee and this relation proves to be really beneficial for the mentee's career development as he is constantly guided by his mentor.



### 2. AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON NPTEL ONLINE COURSES AND ITS BENEFITS DATE:18.01. 2020

National Program for Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) is an initiative by Seven Indian Institutes of Technology (IIT Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras and Roorkee) and Indian Institute of Science (IISc) for creating course contents in Engineering and Science. NPTEL as a project originated from many deliberations between IITs, Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) and Carnegie Mellon University (CMU) during the years 1999-2003. Contents for the above courses were based on the model curriculum suggested by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and the syllabi of major affiliating Universities in India.

A NPTEL meeting was conducted by Principal Dr. Mohammed Yousuf Ali and NPTEL Central coordinator Mr. Abdul Raees in the S & H department of Lords Institute of Engineering and Technology on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2020. All the faculties of the department attended the meeting and discussed about the Registration process of the NPTEL courses. The registration and completion of one course for each semester is mandatory by the AICTE.



### 3. REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS

DATE:26.01. 2020

Lords Institute of Engineering and Technology celebrated the 71st Republic Day with great pride and patriotism on 26 January, 2020. The ceremony began with the hoisting of the tricolor flag, the pride of our Nation by the honorable Chairman Mr. CA Basha Moinuddin sir along with Secretary madam and Vice-Chairman sir. This was followed by the rendition of the National Anthem by the dignitaries and the august gathering and followed by speeches. The management honoured and recognised the extra efforts taken by the faculty in various disciplines.

Dr.Sasikiran, Dean I year addressed the gathering emphasising on the importance of Republic Day and how one has to inculcate good behaviour in order to be the better citizens of the Nation. Quoting the example of Lahore where Republic Day was celebrated with great fervour for the first time, Mrs.Rizwana Begum madam, Secretary, LIET said that it was the festival of Nation. She also announced that 13 faculty members will be felicitated for their strenuous efforts in various fields.

The Chairman, Mr. C.A. Basha Mohiuddin sir spoke on the oneness of the Constitution wherein the interests, race, environment, habits and lingual differed yet everyone were treated equally by the Constitution. India is a country of diverse language, heritage, culture and the framing of the Constitution is done keeping in mind the interest of an individual in the upper strata to that of a common man who belongs to the lower strata of the community, he said.

He also added that the benefits and advantages written in the constitution was percolated even to the last man. Despite all these we witness many people who are facing poverty and around 10,000 villages which lack proper roads and schools.

He also urged the faculty to ponder oneself as to what is our contribution to the country. Some may contribute in the form of wealth, others through knowledge and character. Quoting the example of Dr.A.P.J. Abdul Kalam who after his retirement as President of India served the Nation as Professor in Anna University, he highlighted that the teachers' profession is the God's profession and hence it is the job of the teachers to inculcate a sense of belonging in the young minds of the students. He said that whenever we think of Gandhiji we think about India and when we think of India it is attributed to Gandhiji.

He also cautioned that one should not spoil the name of the country, both in India as well as in other countries and explained this by telling about the honeybees. Like how the Queen kills the bees which gather bad nectar that spoils the enter honey, similarly one should avoid people who bring bad name to the country. He also appreciated the flawless contribution of Japan in its development.

The event geared for the next stage that is Prize Distribution. The management honoured and recognised the extra efforts taken by the faculty in various disciplines.

The gathering was spellbound by the enormous generosity extended by the management to Mr. Mohit Tomar working in the administrative office who was presented a cheque of Rs.15000 for his medical emergency.

The programme came to end by the vote of thanks proposed by Syeda Nusrath Fathima, HOD, Dept. of English. She showed her gratitude towards the management who gave rewards to encourage and appreciate the hard work of the faculty.

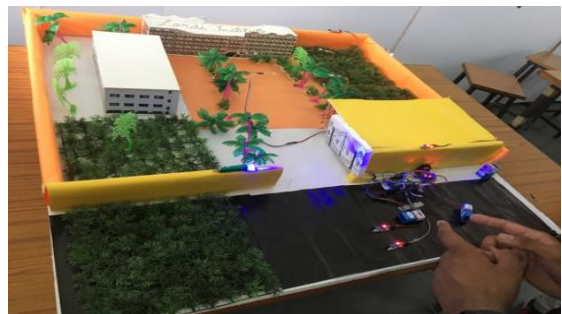

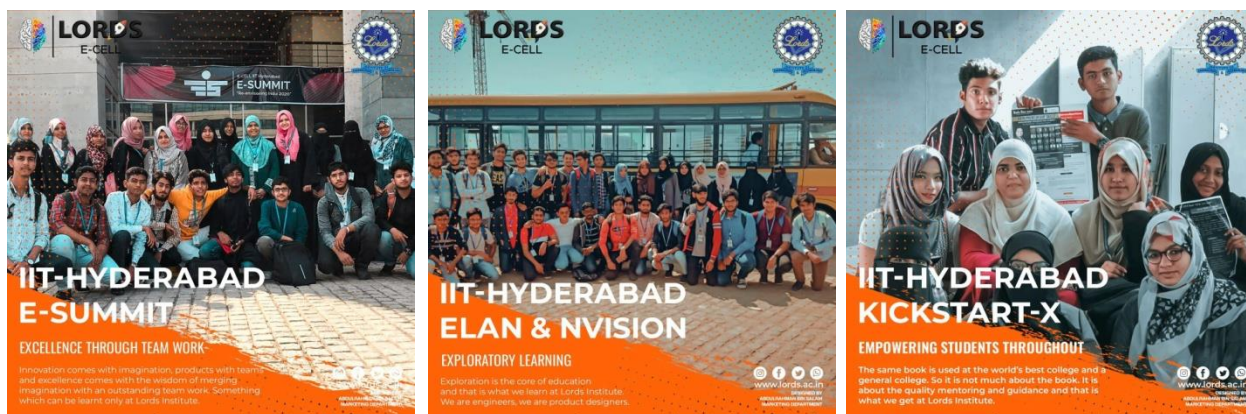
