

Title:- Investor Awareness Education by SEBI Webinar for MBA Students of LIET - SEBI, Hyderabad







Second day Three resource persons sessions was conducted and it was followed by Valedictory session.

In the Inaugural Session, the Hon'ble chief guest was Barrister Shamim Haider Patwary, member of Parliament, Dhaka, Bangladesh and Chairperson board of Trustees, Dhaka International University, Dhaka, Bangladesh. The Guest of Honor of this session was Prof. R Nageswar Rao, HOD, DBM, Osmania University. The session started with the silent prayer, which was followed by the welcome address and about the E Seminar was given by Dr. Syed Hamid Mohiuddin Quadri, HOD, MBA, LIET. The host for the day Mrs J Jayalakshmi, Asst prof. MBA, LIET, has presented the brief profile of the LIET and MBA Department to the Digneteries and participants. Principal LIET, Dr. C V Narsimhulu, has addressed the session and emphasized on importance of conducting such events in the present situation.


The Key Note Address was delivered by Chief Guest Prof. Barrister Shamim Haider Patwary Member of Parliament, Bangladesh Member, Standing Committee on Ministry of Law & Parliamentary Affairs & Chairman, Board of Trustees (BoT) Dhaka International University, Bangladesh. In his address, he has shown the positive side of the pandemic by giving the example that due to the virtual world, he could handle four tasks in two hours in two hours which may have taken much longer time in other way. He also mentioned that every cricis will give several opportunities as a chance to grab and move ahead. In his address, he adviced to reshape the tihnking and strategies which were not fruitful prior to pandemic. As an opportunity, pandemic may be considered to rebuilt the strategies that may develop the economic conditions of the society.

The inaugural session came to end with the vote of thanks given by Mrs. Vanitha K. B., Asst. Prof., MBA, LIET.



After the inaugural session on day one, two technical sessions were held where eminent resource persons has delivered their lectures. The first session was of Prof. Bholanath Dutta, President MTC, Bengaluru, on "Digital Transformation" where he emphasized on the challenges faced by individuals due to the lockdown in maintaining the physical communication with each other, specially, the students and teachers interaction in offline classes. He also discussed about the monetary transactions, which were stuck or paused for a certain period.

However, this was replaced by digital mode, in which this loss has been converted as an opportunity. The second session was of Prof Kaukab Azeem, KFUPM on "Imapct and Challenges of the Pandemic on Higher Education in new normal" COVID-19 has dramatically reshaped the way global education is delivered. Millions of learners were affected by educational institution closures due to the pandemic, which resulted in the largest online movement in the history of education. With this sudden shift away from classrooms in many parts of the globe, universities had to rapidly shift to virtual and digital strategies. Many believe that the adoption of online distance learning will persist after pandemic.



Day - 2

The International E-Seminar on Day-2, Three Technical sessions were held where eminent resource persons has delivered theor lectures. The first session was of **Prof Badiuddin Ahmed**, DMC, SCBM, MANUU gave lecture on "**Recent Advancement in Management and Technology**" Technologies are playing a crucial role in keeping our society functional in a time of lockdowns and quarantines. Moreover, these technologies may have a long-lasting impact beyond COVID-19. These new policies, such as lockdowns and social distancing measures, have


resulted in technological advancement and new means of interaction with government, businesses, and citizens.





Then second session was of by **Prof Shaukat Ali**, HoD, Commerce Department, AIAP College of Commerce & Economics, University of Mumbai on "Opportunities and Challenges in **Human Resource**" The COVID-19 has grandly shaken all organizations, creating a complex and challenging environment for managers and human resource management (HRM) practitioners, who need to find ingenious solutions to ensure the continuity of their companies and to help their employees to cope with this extraordinary crisis. He suggested to identify the main challenges and opportunities, and to provide insights into future directions in HRM.





Then third session was taken over by Prof Ravinder Rena, North West University Mahikeng, and South Africa. Presented a lecture on **"Economic Challenges in New Normal"** he mentioned that the COVID-19 pandemic has gravely wounded the world economy with serious consequences effecting all communities and individuals. Moving rapidly across borders, along the principal arteries of the global economy. The industries that survive the downturn, including those that are vital to our economic system, will face a long period of adjustment to working and interacting virtually rather than face to face. In addition, industries and companies will have to prepare for future pandemics by building redundancies into their operations and supply chains.



Then the valedictory program was started by welcoming dignitaries to the program and Review of two days E-seminar by K.B.Vanitha and then presedential remarks given by Principal Dr. C.V. Narasinhulu.
