Through the reference 1st cited, the Government of Telangana has accorded permission to the Minority Educational Institutions for change of affiliation from one University to another University. Accordingly, Lords Institute of Engineering & Technology, Sy. No. 32, Himayathsagar, Golconda Post, Near TSPA Junction, Hyderabad (a Minority Institution) has been permitted for change of affiliation from JNTUH to Osmania University from the academic year 2019-2020 as per guidelines stipulated by the Osmania University.

Based on the approval of the AICTE and on the recommendation of the University Inspection Committee, sanction is hereby accorded for grant of extension of provisional affiliation to **Lords Institute of Engineering & Technology**, Sy. No. 32, Himayathsagar, Golconda Post, Near TSPA Junction, Hyderabad for the academic year **2019-2020** to offer the following Engineering Courses with the intake mentioned against each:

3. All systems to be replaced with new ones.

5. B.E. (Civil) Engineering Course: (180)

1. Four Professors, Eight Associate Professors and Twenty two (24) Assistant Professors to be appointed through a duly constituted Selection Committee as per OU norms.
2. One separate Computers Graphics labs need to be created.

6. B.E. (Mechanical) Engineering Course: (240)

1. Three Professors, Eleven Associate Professors and Thirty Three Assistant Professors to be appointed through a duly constituted Selection Committee as per OU norms.
2. One foreman, Eleven Lab Assistants and Eight Lab Technician to be appointed.

7. The Faculty to be deputed for Refresher Courses/Orientation Programmes/Faculty Development Programmes conducted by Osmania University/Other Institutions.

As such, if any short fall in the above cadre, the college has to recruit them immediately through a duly constituted selection committee as per AICTE (as per AICTE Process Hand Book for the year 2019-2020) and OU norms. 
