- A Single Examiner conducts the evaluation process, assigning marks to candidates. If a student raises discrepancies in the assigned marks, the system initiates a second evaluation to ensure accuracy and fairness
- Re-valuation/Re-counting of answer scripts is permissible for MBA students. This option extends to both regular and backlog examinations.
- Make-up / Instant Examinations will be conducted for IV semester outgoing students within one month from the date of declaration of results.
- If a student fails in any one or more courses of the Semester End Examination (SEE) in any semester, they are permitted to appear for the backlog examinations in the subsequent semester.

- i. Any Students detained due to Shortage of Attendance/Academic Credits/ SEE Exams fees not paid and promoted/readmitted will be applicable for same resolution of LR21 or LR23 or LR24 which includes total 104 Credits for LR21 regulation and 124 Credits for LR23 regulation and 104 Credits for LR24 regulation.
 - ii. Credits should match as per Course Structure of regulation adapted while preparing the SEE Question Paper.
 - iii. There is NO Substitute Subjects for MBA Program as they are opting same regulation if readmitted.

Item No.11: Suggestions on Innovative Teaching learning Methods.

- ❖ Members suggested to have separate faculty for new specialization like Healthcare Management and Supplychain Management.
- ❖ Members Suggested to have External Industry Experts like Corporate Trainers, Politicians, Public Officers to give Guest Lecture, Seminars and Workshops and have an interaction with students
- ❖ Members suggested to include case study for every subject after each unit to enhance the problem solving and equip corporate skills in the students.
- ❖ Members Suggested to include Students as part of Research.
- ❖ Members suggested to introduce problem based learning and project based learning for the courses of analytical and application oriented.
- ❖ To conduct at least one Industrial visit related to real time application of the subject for better understanding.
- ❖ To get students ready for NET/SET examination and other competitive exams (IES, UPSC, etc.)
- ❖ To identify slow learners and conduct remedial classes and additional tests.

Resolution: The members noted and approved.

Item No. 12: Suggestions on Collaborations, MOUs, Certifications, Internship, Project Work and Comprehensive Viva-Voce.

- BoS members suggested one internship mandatory with/without credits which is to undergo by the student after second semester to include research and development activity in it.
- BoS members suggested to have an MOU signed with HCU for Healthcare Specialization and IPE for Business Analytics.
- BoS members appreciated and suggested to conduct Project Viva and Comprehensive Viva Voce as per the Course Structure.
- BoS members suggested to encourage the students to write at-least one article in their third semester.
- BoS members suggested students of Healthcare Specialization to have more practical exposure then the theory.
- Awareness programs to publish research articles in Web of Science and Scopus Indexed Journals to be conducted.
- BoS members suggested to have NPTEL and other Certification Courses included in the MBA Program. Students should be informed well in advance above what courses and certificate they should do during the semester.
- Students projects should be aligned with different SGD goals.
- Internshala was recommended by BoS members as a platform for Projects and Internships

Resolution: The members noted and approved.

BoS Chairperson suggested to modify the course structure as per the above suggestions given by the Members and take their approval.

It is further resolved that the proposed course structure may be modified in subsequent BoS meetings.

Members of Board of Studies recommended the above resolutions and approved course structure and syllabi is to be presented in the Academic Council for approval.
