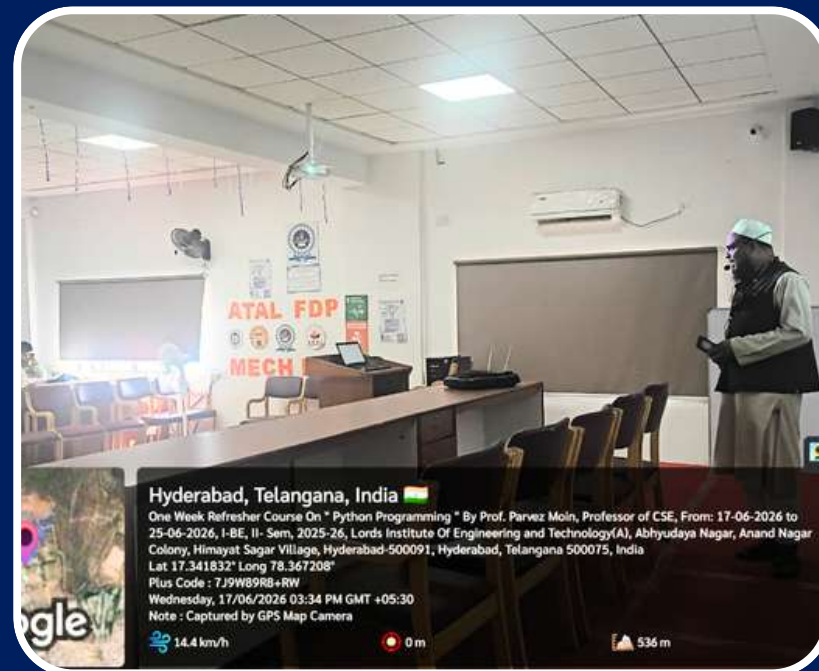
12. World Environment Day

These guest lectures were highly beneficial in improving both conceptual knowledge and examination performance.



17. Guest Lecture on Basic Electrical Engineering

The Department of Science & Humanities, Lords Institute of Engineering and Technology, organized a guest lecture on Synchronous Generator on 10.06.2026 in the CSD-A Class Room. The session was delivered by Mr. J. P. Balaji, Assistant Professor, with the objective of enhancing students' understanding of the construction, working principle, and applications of synchronous generators. The resource person explained the basic construction of a synchronous generator, including the stator, rotor, and excitation system. The working principle based on Faraday's Law of Electromagnetic Induction was discussed, along with the concepts of synchronous speed, frequency, EMF generation, and voltage regulation. The differences between salient pole and cylindrical rotor machines were also highlighted.



18. Guest Lecture On Engineering Chemistry

The Department of Science and Humanities, Lords Institute of Engineering & Technology (Autonomous), organized a two-day Guest Lecture on Engineering Chemistry on 10–11 November 2025 for B.E. First Year students in Lecture Halls 742, 735, and 723.
